



## ~ Red Cross by the Numbers ~

The American Red Cross in Northeast Nebraska provided services to more than **26,369 people** throughout Cedar, Cuming, Dixon, Knox, Madison, Pierce, Stanton, Thurston and Wayne counties last fiscal year.

- 21** households were responded to following a disaster.
- 38** individuals received food, clothing, shelter, mental health counseling and/or financial assistance following fires to their permanent residences.
- 125** individuals were given Pandemic Flu information.
- 34** military families were provided emergency communication services.
- 33** individuals received prevention education on HIV/Aids.
- 68** youth were certified in Babysitter's Training.
- 205** volunteers provided hours of service for disaster response, classroom instructors, governance, administrative functions, and other services.
- 24** military families were briefed on Red Cross services.
- 615** individuals were provided Community Disaster Education and disaster preparedness information.
- 1,162** people were certified in CPR, First Aid, and Automatic External Defibrillator (AED).
- 1,441** children and youth were certified in swimming and lifeguard training.
- 186** individuals were given information and referral services through the Emergency Services department.
- 7,530** pints of blood were collect throughout Northeast Nebraska.
